New Business

Our groomer is five years old so the process to investigate options and replace it has begun with approval of the membership. Tim Blackwell made the motion to give the Board of Directors authorization to pursue replacement. Tank Jonas provided a second. Unanimous approval. The groomer's value remains good. Options of either a trade-in or outright sale will be considered. Although adding another groomer was briefly discussed, the grooming reimbursement rate at the present time doesn't favor adding another machine. A five year rotation of machines does seem to present the best value for us regarding potential maintenance requirements and trade or sale offset.

<u>AWSC insurance</u> in the amount of \$3000 has been reinstated at no additional cost to members and their families. See the AWSC website.

"Of the year" awards nominations are being taken by AWSC until June 15th. See the AWSC website for a nomination form.

Snowmobile Council News. Gary Hilgendorf provided a meeting brief of information current as of 1/16/2023. More money is going into enforcement. There were 214,738 snowmobiles registered this year. There were 16,278 non-resident Trail Passes this year, or \$488,340. The 16,278 ten dollar Trail Passes generated another \$162,780. In addition to registration and trail pass money, a small percentage of the gas tax (based on an 'estimated average' number of gallons of gas used for each registered machine) provides money for snowmobile trail maintenance. Knight Owls will have a voting delegate at the March meeting in Green Bay.

Northwoods Riders certified 43 children in snowmobile safety this past fall. They have a "RIDE RIGHT" trail theme (and we hope to get there when everyone will "STAY BETWEEN

THE MARKERS". They also had a trailside cookout and a Club breakfast.

<u>Election of Officers</u>. All were reminded that next meeting we will make a first call for nominations of Vice President, Treasurer, three Regular Board Members, and one Business Member.

<u>Business Forms</u>. Nancy Swan reminded the businesses to fill out their forms completely. All the data requested is utilized to help your business.

<u>Trail Apps</u> There have been some problems entering data into the Polaris App lately and Polaris hasn't been forthcoming about their problems or when they might be fixed. The BRP App was briefly discussed for its own problems related to creating a ride route. The GTS App (Groomer Tracking App) had some good reviews from the crowd.

50-50 Raffle was won by Tammy Blackwell.

<u>Adjournment</u> was at 8:22 following a motion by Jason Davis, a second by Tim Kloehn, and unanimous approval.
